

Pandemic Response

In the event of a pandemic we shall follow all guidelines set forth by the state of Ohio and through The Department of Job and Family Services. A temporary pandemic license shall be filled out immediately to try to keep the organization operational for all members.

Staggered drop off and pick-ups shall be put in place for safety. Daily classroom sanitation schedules shall be introduced and followed for everyone's well-being. Children shall be split between two different classrooms to ensure limited exposure and the addition of extra sanitation practices shall be introduced into the class daily schedule.

Face shields shall be required for all staff and teachers. Adults entering or exiting the facilities shall wear protective facial coverings whenever on the property. Children may be asked to wear facial coverings during group play however certain circumstances may arise and it is okay if they cannot keep one on during these times.

Classes may be combined, and regular open program days may be reduced in order to fulfill registration and financial needs, in such uncertain times.

During times of financial duress due to a pandemic or similar situation the board administrator and president shall have the authority to sign for necessary loans or grants to keep the facility fully operational.
